This Luger 9 M/M Pistol No. 8607 was assembled and thoroughly tested in 1928 by Mr. Wm. Daniels, gunsmith and toolmaker, who was inspector of a consignment of these pistols being made for The Dutch Army by the Royal Woolwich Arsenal at Woolwich, London England and given to his brother Albert, since deceased, who gave it to me, his brother-in-law.

Wm. Daniels, who dies in 1959, was one of a family of gunsmiths all of whom worked either at the Royal Enfield Arms Factory at Enfield, or at Woolwich Arsenal, some making Enfield Rifles and one other doing the rifling on the largest naval guns.

Wm. Daniels grandfather, Mr. T. Pilling was the co-inventor with Sir Hiram Maxim of the famous Maxim Machine Gun, and was the sole maker of the original model of same.

I have tested this pistol on various targets and can vouch for its accuracy and action.
